Particular attention is given to the City's public hospital system, new and proposed projects at major healthcare facilities, and innovative financing tools.

**EDUCATION, ARTS & CULTURE**

The Education, Arts & Culture Committee explores ways the Building Congress can strengthen its advocacy of design and construction activities in the higher education sector.

**PLANNING, GROWTH & SUSTAINABILITY**

The Planning, Growth & Sustainability Committee monitors City and State economic development initiatives and private sector development trends. The committee also considers the impact of regulatory procedures on economic development and opportunities for resource-conserving design and construction.

**PUBLIC BUILDING & PROCUREMENT**

The Public Building & Procurement Committee monitors the New York City School Construction Authority, New York City Department of Design and Construction, New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development, DASNY, and other builders of public facilities in New York City. The committee also focuses on efforts to make public procurement and construction practices more efficient and productive.

**TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE**

The Transportation & Infrastructure Committee looks at the capital programs of the City of New York, MTA, the Port Authority of New York & New Jersey, New York State Department of Transportation, and other government agencies responsible for building the City's core infrastructure. The Committee also monitors relevant legislation and policy issues impacting the City's infrastructure.

**YOUNG PROFESSIONALS COMMITTEE**

The Young Professionals Committee expands on the Building Congress' efforts to attract, engage, retain, and develop the next generation of industry leaders through a range of activities including networking with peers and senior industry professionals; targeting young professional development programs, activities, and mentoring; and increasing awareness of, and fundraising for, the New York Building Foundation.
